

Sailing the Mergui Archipelago




Lying off the southern tip of Myanmar in the blue waters of the Andaman Sea are the 800 island of the little-visited Mergui Archipelago. Most of the islands are uninhabitated, at least most of the time, unless a Moken (Sea Gypsy) family have set up temporary home there. Nearly all of them have stunning white sand beaches, beautiful coves, tropical jungles or intricate mangrove forests.

The opportunities for watersports, snorkelling and diving abound with world class dive sites that are rarely visited and host wildlife in abundance; from majestic manta rays and sharks to fluttering lionfish and the children's favourite - the colourful clownfish. This sailing itinerary is the perfect way to explore the islands; perhaps you might like to combine this trip with a few days exploring the rest of Myanmar.

DAY	ITINERARY	ACCOMMODATION & MEALS
1	Arrive Kawthaung Board your yacht and set sail out toward the islands for swimming, sundowners and dinner.	Cabin on yacht (B, L&D)
2	Sailing and exploring Sail on the amazing snorkelling spots around Tang La Bo, bird spotting at Pony Island before anchoring near Nyaung Wee Island.	Cabin on yacht (B, L&D)
3	Sailing and exploring Head into the Lampi National Park marine reserve; perhaps meet some Moken villagers or explore the mangrove inlets.	Cabin on yacht (B, L&D)
4	Sailing and exploring Set sail toward Nga Namm for snorkelling, kayaking or fishing and to Kyun Pila, a great place for Scubadiving.	Cabin on yacht (B, L&D)
5	Sailing and exploring Stop off at 115 Island for a little jungle trekking to get a feel for the landscape, vegetation and wildlife above the water-line.	Cabin on yacht (B, L&D)
6	Return to Kawthaung Continue your journey around Myanmar or stay longer in Mergui at the sublime resort of We Ale on Lampi Island, the perfect place to relax for a few days. Explore, unwind and learn about the turtle conservation work in the national park.	(B)
